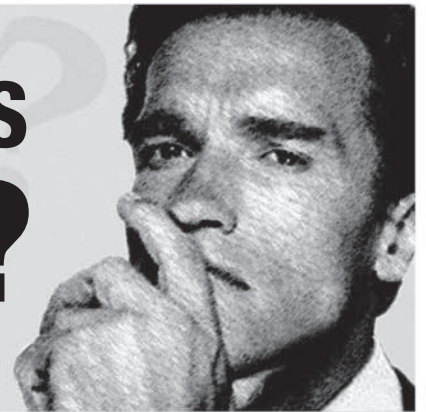


Hollywood cares about AIDS Does Arnold?



California lags behind the rest of the nation when it comes to AIDS prevention. And only the Governor can change that.

Syringe sharing is the second most common cause of HIV/AIDS and the leading cause of hepatitis-C in our state. Yet California is 1 of only 5 states that still make it illegal for a pharmacist to sell a syringe without a prescription.

Studies have proven that allowing adults to purchase sterile syringes slows the spread of disease without contributing to increases in drug use, crime or unsafe discard of syringes.

We need ACTION from the Governor! We need his immediate support for SB 1159, legislation that will allow pharmacists to sell up to 10 syringes without a prescription—saving thousands of lives and millions of healthcare dollars.
